Community Science (Girls only)	60	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A pass in two-year Intermediate Examination (10+2) with BPC/MPC/MBPC subjects. • Candidates who have passed a three-year Diploma course in Home Science can also apply for admission under 10% supernumerary seats quota.

Criteria for selection:

- The candidates shall be selected based on merit in **optional subjects** of the two-year Intermediate or its equivalent Examination as per the rule of reservation. In case of other equivalent examinations passed by the candidates, the weightage of marks obtained in optional subjects shall be reckoned on par with those of the two-year Intermediate examination.
- In case of a tie in aggregate marks in optional subjects obtained by two or more candidates, the total marks secured in the Intermediate (10+2) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidates shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference for the seat.
- 10% of total intake of this course is reserved for Diploma Holders who have passed three year Diploma course in Home Science.

Age:

- Candidates for admission into this course in the University shall be required to have completed **17 years** of age with an upper age limit of **22 years** as on **31st December, 2019**. The upper age limit in respect of **SC** and **ST** candidates shall be **25 years, while** for **Physically Challenged** candidates it shall be **27 years** as on **31st December, 2019**.

Reservation of seats for the candidates from Non-Municipal Areas:

- 40% of the seats in this course are reserved for candidates from rural areas. Candidates seeking admission under this category should produce a certificate(s) from the Heads of Institutions that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class/Intermediate (any four years). The relevant information must be filled in the proforma as prescribed in **FORM-I** of the application and duly signed by the Head of the institution concerned.

- If Form-I is not filled in/duly signed by the concerned Head of Institution or officer along with office seal, the claim of the candidates under this category will be rejected.

Among the seats available for admission into B.Sc.(Hons.) Community Science of the University, 3% are reserved for the Physically Handicapped/Challenged candidates. The candidate seeking the benefit of the reservation should present himself/herself before a Selection Committee comprising of Residential Medical Officer, Specialists in the concerned fields of medicine and Deans of Faculty, which shall examine the suitability of the candidates to the course based on their degree of disability which shall be based on their performance in the screening tests and the decision of the committee shall be final for the purpose of admission.

Allocation of seats in favour of Local candidates in relation to Local area:

- 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates and 15% of seats are un-reserved.

Hostel facility:

- Hostel accommodation for the candidates shall be provided subject to the availability.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of Counselling/Admission:

- a. SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, as evidence of the Date of Birth.
- b. Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate/Diploma or its Equivalent).
- c. Bonafide / Study Certificate from 6th to 12th Class.
- d. Transfer Certificate.
- e. Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (Form-I).
- f. The latest certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- g. Physically Challenged Certificate.
- h. Children of Armed Personnel Certificate / Defence Personnel Certificate.
- i. National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificate.
- j. Sports and Games Certificates.

NOTE:

- **The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed.**
- **15% of seats in B.Sc.(Hons.) Community Science under ICAR Quota will be filled up by ICAR** through the online counselling based on ranks obtained in UG-AIEEA-2019 examination conducted at national level. The leftover seats will not be filled up by the University.
- **The certificates of the candidates under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) shall be verified by the authorities concerned.**
- The Counselling under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned.
- **Fees once paid to the University shall not be refunded under any circumstances.**
- **If a candidate cancels his/her admission, he/she must pay the prescribed cancellation fee.**
- Candidates called for counselling will have to attend at their own cost only. **One of the Parents / Guardian** of the candidate shall be **allowed for counselling.**
- The candidate who secures a seat, should submit the certificates **in Original along with the prescribed fees** at the time of counselling itself.
- **The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.**
- Candidates are informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for counselling does not guarantee the allotment of seat.
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University will take appropriate action against the individuals concerned and his/her application will be summarily rejected.
